VTS-kodit helps Tampere grow

When writing this, I have worked as the executive director of VTS-kodit for less than two months. I accepted the job eagerly and humbly in mid-March, and it has been a real pleasure to become a part of the VTS community. Thank you for a warm welcome to both the staff and the tenants.

Our foundation has a big mission in producing quality living for an affordable price while helping the city region grow. Tampere is the most attractive city in Finland, and the growth objectives are large; the population is growing rapidly. According to the city's growth strategy, the need to build new affordable rental apartments is 570 apartments a year, and approximately half of them are built by VTS-kodit. We have built a lot in

recent years, and now we will build even more.

The market around us is changing, and we need to develop too, preferably in the forefront. This means that we need to continuously respond to the wishes of our customers. There are plenty of pacemakers, competing housing companies, in the rental apartment market, so VTSkodit needs to stay competitive and attractive to customers.

The rent level of VTS-kodit is - depending slightly on how it is calculated – at least twelve per cent lower than our competitors', and we

aim to keep the difference at least as large in the future, as well. Last year, our tenant satisfaction was 3.8 (on a scale from 1 to 5), and now we aim to raise it to 3.9.

I believe that we can achieve all this with our competent staff and will maintain our position on the top in the future, as well. The maintenance and cleaning of the properties also plays a large role in tenant satisfaction. Thank you to our cooperation partners for quality work.

I have already had the pleasure of getting to know the very active tenant activities of our buildings, and I consider it to be of great significance to both our tenants and the company. Tenant activities increase neighbour interaction, improve living satisfaction and create a sense

of community that is very important especially to people living alone.

In turn, VTS-kodit will benefit from longer tenancies and a lower tenant turnover rate. The number of so-called idle apartments decreases, which helps to keep the rent level affordable.

I wish a sunny summer to all the tenants of VTS-kodit, and see you at Särkänniemi!

"Together we will always achieve more"

■ IN MARCH, VTS-kodit received a new executive director, Master of Science Satu Eskeli**nen**. She was born and bred in Tampere, a gal from Tesoma.

"I was born in Pispala, but I lived my childhood and youth on Tesomajärvenkatu. Tampere is so much of a home to me that I did not leave for Helsinki even when my first employer (IBM) moved there. Already then, my husband Ant**ti** and I chose to build our careers in Tampere.

The couple lives in the centre of Tampere, and they have two grown children. On her free time, Satu Eskelinen likes to hit the jogging trails.

The customer is paramount

Tenants have the duty to clean the refrigerator's drain hole a couple of times a year, or when needed. Otherwise, the drain tube can get clogged and the refrigerator can start leaking water on the floor.

Clean the drain hole with a cloth and open the possible clog with a cotton swab. If the clog is deeper in the tube, you may open it for example with a wire.

Vacuum underneath and behind the refrigerator once a year. At the same time, make sure that the end of the drain tube is in the evaporating dish on the compressor. If the refrigerator does not have automatic defrost, defrost it when needed.



Retrieve the keys from the automated pick-up system

VTS-kodit will start using the automated Smartpickbox key pick-up system. It is located in the entrance lobby of the former Anttila department store, next to the R-Kioski, in Kuninkaankatu 14.

The keys for future rental contracts will be retrieved from the automated pick-up system of VTS-kodit from now on. The keys can be retrieved from the pick-up system from the first day of the contract onwards within the opening hours of K-Supermarket Kuninkaankulma.

Now the retrieval of keys will be possible in the evenings and at the weekends, as well. The keys will be stored in the pick-up boxes for three days on average.

The simple pick-up system works with the same principle as Posti's Parcel Point. The customer will receive a pick-up code, which is entered into the pick-up system. After this, the locker will open, and the customer can take their keys.

Installing a dishwasher

Installing a dishwasher and a drip tray is free of charge for residents. When a resident moves or buys a new dishwasher, the installation is ordered via VTS-kodit, palveluisannoitsijat@vts.fi.

The dishwasher will be installed within ten weekdays of the order being placed by a company chosen by VTS-kodit.
